What is the course about?

Duration

24 months

Days per week

1 day per week

Some of the main subjects covered include:

- NVQ 3 Amenity Horticulture – Landscaping
 - Project planning and information management
 - Managing planted areas for their general amenity
 - H&S including how to respond to emergencies within the workplace
 - Estimating resource requirements and programming work
 - Specification and monitoring landscape maintenance
- Technical Certificate – Landscaping
 - Garden design principles and practice
 - Plant identification
 - Site surveying and levelling
- First Aid At Work – 4 day course
- Key Skills

Who is the course for?

The course is for anyone who is aged 16 or over who is currently employed in the landscape gardening industry and wants to either develop existing skills or move on to more complex tasks relating to their field of work.

What are the requirements to get on the course?

- You will need to be employed in the landscape gardening industry, working in a supervisory role and be able to attend college once a week
- NVQ Level 2 Amenity Horticulture or equivalent qualifications or demonstrate substantial relevant occupational experience
- Minimum 4 GCSE's Grade A-C or Key skills at Level 1
- You will need to be self motivated in order to carry out some of the coursework in your own time
- A reasonable level of physical fitness

So how much will the course cost?

If you are 16-18 then the course is FREE! If you are 19 or above there is a fee for the course but this is normally met by the employer.



Are there any exams?

The majority of the course will be assessed via practical and written assignments. In addition you will need to generate an NVQ Level 3 portfolio of evidence that will include witness statements, task reports and photographs. There will be end tests associated with the technical certificate and key skills.
