### Environmental Conservation NVQ Level 2

This course is ideal for those who are already working in or wish to work in countryside management. It is a practical qualification providing the opportunity to acquire the essential skills needed for employment in conservation and countryside recreation. There are no formal entry requirements but it is helpful if applicants are already working in the field or have undertaken some voluntary conservation work.

The course runs one day a month for a year however students need to obtain additional practical experience to gain the full qualification. This may be obtained through work experience or voluntary work which can be arranged through the College. Applicants also need to have a good level of literacy and organisational skills, as they will be required to produce a portfolio of evidence of work.
