



Animal Management Advanced Diploma (Level 3)

This course has been designed to prepare you for a rewarding and professional career in the animal industry. Whilst having a strong practical basis in animal husbandry, the courses also covers essential concepts in applied animal sciences.

Floristry and Event Styling

Technical Certificate in Floristry (Access to T Level)

This course will introduce you to a range of commercial designs and allow you to gain practical experience by working alongside your qualification.

Learning objectives: You will create portfolios of evidence, gaining proficiency in preparing and caring for cut flowers, foliage, and plants. This course has a focus on the development of transferable traditional and contemporary skills, and encourages versatility by teaching students how to use a wide selection of materials and different mediums across a diverse range of floral designs.
