Capel Manor College is proud to be London's environmental college. With five campuses across the capital, our sites offer unique outdoor learning environments that reflect the diverse subjects we teach and the communities we serve.

Crystal Palace Park

Located within the National Sports
Centre, this campus specialises in
animal care and environmental
education. It is home to Crystal Palace
Park Farm, where students gain
practical experience caring for animals.
Classrooms are situated in the Jubilee
Stand Building.

Enfield

Our largest campus, Enfield is a vibrant hub for horticulture, animal care, floristry, and saddlery. Set within 30 acres of gardens, it includes a zoo, glasshouses, laboratories and historic stables. Students also access Forty Hall Farm which is a working organic farm with a vineyard, market garden and shop providing hands-on training across land-based subjects.



Gunnersbury Park

Situated within a historic park in West London, this campus supports courses in animal management and horticulture. It features outdoor teaching areas and a thriving animal collection. The campus regularly hosts seasonal plant sales, helping students engage with the local community.

Mottingham

Set within woodlands and green spaces, this campus includes gardens, glasshouses and an animal unit with exotic and domestic species. The site has recently been redeveloped as part of the 'Unlocking Potential' project, supporting sustainable and low-carbon learning environments.

Regent's Park

Located in the heart of central London, this campus exclusively delivers adult courses in horticulture and garden design. Students benefit from access to the Crown Estate Gardens and other high-profile green spaces, in partnership with The Royal Parks. It offers a peaceful, adult-focused setting with strong links to the professional landscaping industry.
