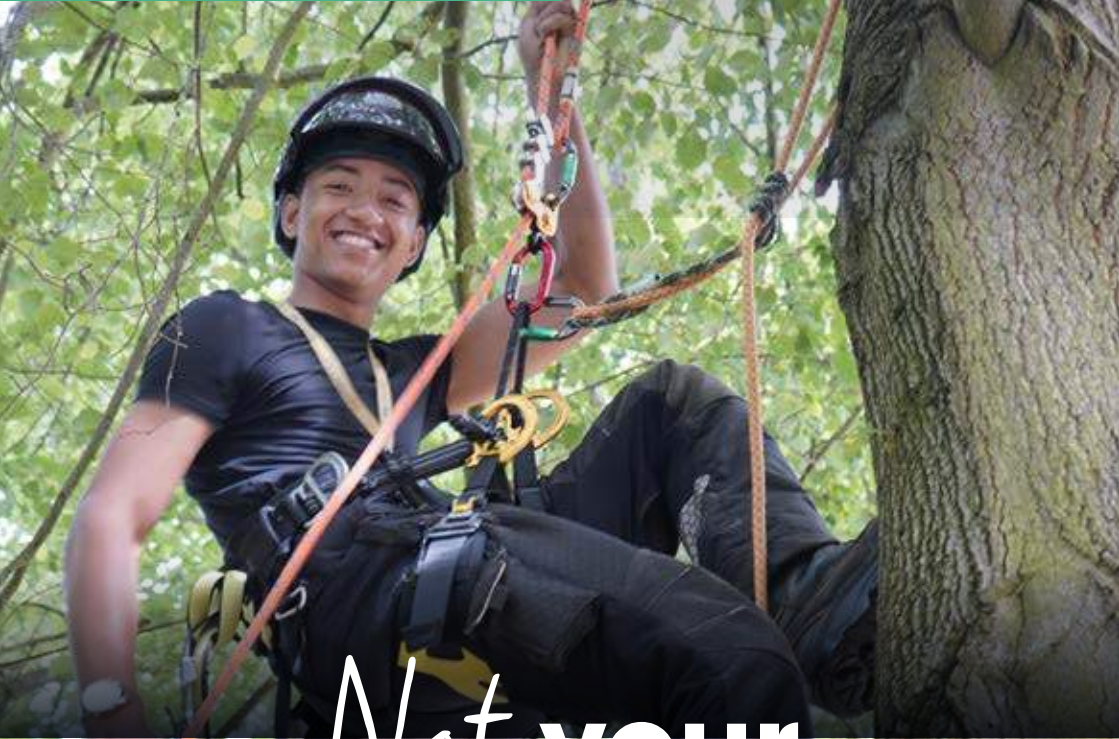

By rail: Mottingham station is a 23 minute walk from the campus, with regular services to London Charing Cross, London Bridge, Cannon Street and Dartford.

By bus: There are a number of bus stops within five minutes' walk of the campus. The closest stops are Jevington Way, Alnwick Road and Mottingham Way.

By car: Mottingham Campus is located on Mottingham Lane, just two minutes' drive from the A20 Sidcup Road/ South Circular Road roundabout.

Pathways

Our Pathways programmes provide essential preparation for vocational courses, apprenticeships, internships, or employment. Partnering with The King's Trust (formerly The Prince's Trust), our courses bridge educational gaps.

Students participate in diverse class-based and practical activities, gaining exposure to the land-based industry and earning vital qualifications in maths and English.

English and maths

Achieving five 4 to 9 GCSE grades (including English and maths), adds £80,000 to your future earnings over a lifetime, according to a study conducted by the Department for Education.

If you have just finished school and have not obtained a pass in GCSE English or maths, you will be able to study these alongside your chosen land-based course. You will benefit from small class sizes, one-to-one support and hands-on learning tailored to your course.
